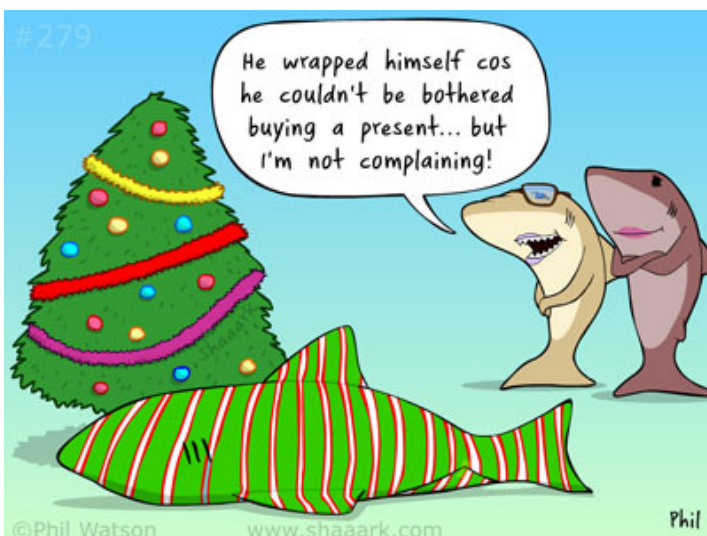

Manager's Column



TIPS FOR WORKING AFTER DARK

This time of year can be tough as daylight savings time begins and darkness sets in during prime time collection hours. The major challenges we face this time of year can include finding locations, dealing with skeptical customers and inclement weather. We can adapt and overcome the challenges if we use the right approaches.

Keep in mind that statistics show that when it gets dark and average temperatures fall, more people go home, and our contact rate increases. See below for helpful tips to overcome common seasonal challenges.

Tips for finding locations in the dark:

1. Revisit locations for a second attempt between 6pm and 8pm.
2. Set follow-up appointments for later in the evening.
3. Have a high-powered flashlight to find addresses on mailboxes.

Tips for working in inclement weather:

1. Check the weather before going to work and dress appropriately. We spend a lot of time outside and need to be prepared for cold or damp weather.
2. Consider layering up as you can always remove layers if needed.
3. Keep an extra Makotek shirt and coat in your vehicle in case of wet weather.
4. Have door tags prefilled with your name and number

Dealing with skeptical customers:

1. Build trust by dressing the part. Follow Makotek dress code by wearing your Makotek shirt and reflective vest. Wear other bright colored, unbranded clothing and avoid black.
2. As it begins to get dark, make sure you are visible by using a flashlight and or headlamp.
3. Use your hazard lights when appropriate.

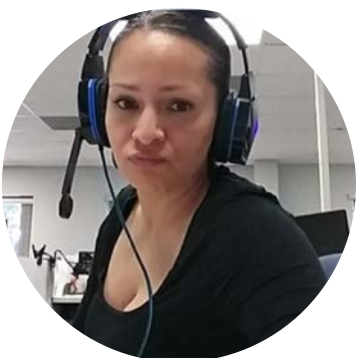
